Tampa Funcoast Subcommittee Report Form

The POLICY Subcommittee met on 1/9/2021 @ 12am before ASC.

We reviewed items discussed at the previous policy meeting, LDO day and handling money, upcoming motions, streamlining ASC and limiting discussion, and printing of the new Policy manual. We will be submitting the annual Policy budget today, as well as the year end report. A new 2021 ASC Policy handbook is available online at tampa-na.org and are trying to have a hard copy to be available at the next LDO day. Our next meeting will be on 2/13/2021 @ 12AM on ZOOM.

POLICY YEAR-END REPORT

My name is Jeremy, and I'm an addict. This is my year-end report for the Policy subcommittee for the year 2020.

As incoming chair, I was tasked with putting together the 2020 ASC Policy Addendum. The outgoing chair did not do this, as was their responsibility. This addendum was supposed to be made available at Jan ASC, but was not completed until Feb ASC. There was no cost for printing the addendum, that was a donation I wanted to provide.

Shortly after printing the addendum, I adapted my own copy of the 2019 ASC Policy. At this time, the policy motions from 2019 were added into the live copy of the policy manual. I kept a tally of all policy motions passed through 2020 and would add passed policy motions each month to the live copy.

Throughout the year, the policy subcommittee carefully considered any and all motions that were brought to the floor before sending to the groups for a vote. We also discovered items in policy that needed correction, and would bring policy motions to the floor for the groups to vote on.

The last bit of work to be done for 2020 was printing the 2021 ASC Policy manual. Before printing, the policy subcommittee reviewed the live copy that was updated throughout the year. We corrected all typos and formatting errors, and made sure all passed policy motions were included in the new policy. We were also able to include a clean, not blurry, copy of motion examples to be printed.

For 2021, I plan on keeping a log of all passed policy motions as well. One of my outgoing duties as policy chair for 2021 will be to provide a 2022 ASC Policy Addendum and Jan 2022 ASC. Keeping a running log throughout the year is much simpler than trying to cram a full

year of motions into 1 month. I also hope to find a suitable replacement as policy chair for 2022 in the spirit of rotation.

- 1) Budget proposal is to maintain exact same funding level as 2020.
- 2) All numbers after October 2020 are estimates.
- 3) H&I zoom accounts have been donated by a member and do not need to be budgeted.
- 4) While unclear when, H&I hopes to resume in person meetings next year, with the expenses that carries.
- 5) Our number of panels is lower (8 now vs 11 pre-covid), however we intend to expand back to that prior level next year and wish to have appropriate funding.
- 6) We were staying consistently under our literature budget pre-covid, and ultimately except that to continue.
- 7) Restarting in person meetings may require extra costs due to larger res-stocking on literature. We except this to balance out our good track record of staying under budget.
